

Dear Families,

Given the uncertainties that face us with COVID-19, we are following guidance from the Archdiocese as well as state and local governments and Jefferson County Schools as we determine best practices for Religious Education classes and Youth Groups for the upcoming year. As with everywhere else, this information is subject to change. Please be sure we have a current email address or that you are signed up for Flocknote to receive updates.

For grades K-5, we plan to offer in-person learning with the following requirements:

- Children and adults will wear masks at all times in the classroom buildings
- We will make every effort to have children and adults spaced 6 feet apart
- Separate entrances will be used, with staggered start and end times for classes
- If enrollment is high, we will be using other parish buildings to provide adequate space

In addition:

- A remote option will be available for Sacramental Preparation Year 1 (Reconciliation) and Year 2 (Confirmation and First Communion) if families express a need for this – this will be combined online instruction and parent instruction.
- A home-school option will be available for all grades this will be completely parent taught (for students in Sacramental Preparation, an interview will be scheduled mid-year and again near the end of the year to ensure readiness to receive the sacraments.) You will need to purchase a Leader Guide if you select this option.

For Youth Groups (6th – 12th grade) we plan to offer in-person meetings with the following requirements:

- Children and adults will wear masks at all times in the classroom buildings
- Be prepared that things may change from week to week, due to unexpected circumstances; we are asking that you be flexible at this time.

In addition:

• We may offer virtual options if there is enough interest. These options may coincide with existing times or they might be a different option all together.

We ask that you complete the enclosed registration form and send it in as soon as possible, **before August 17**th, so we can determine classroom needs, catechist assignments, and purchase books.

Payment can be mailed in with your form or made in person after classes begin.

We will be in touch with more details as we gather information from you and other families. Thank you for your patience. May we all navigate these challenging times with grace and love for one another.



Please read this entire letter before enrolling your child for Religious Education classes. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, we are unable to hold registration in the church gathering space. **All forms should be returned by mail, fax, email, or in person before August 17th.**

<u>PARENT CATECHESIS</u> – the Archdiocese has requested that we present specific parent catechesis programs for parents of children in Sacramental Preparation. Due to constraints on space and staff, we will only provide this opportunity for parents of children in Year 1 and Year 2 Sacramental Preparation this year. (Our Family Catechesis will not take place as it has in past years.) Parent catechesis will likely not begin until the 2nd half of the year.

<u>COVID-19</u> — A survey has been sent to all currently enrolled K-5 families regarding in-person vs. remote learning for this year. If you have not already completed the survey, please email Brenda at bmaxwell@saintjudelakewood.org to have the link for the survey sent to you.

- Religious Education classes are available for children in grades K 5; Youth Group is open to children in grades 6 12. See Registration forms for schedules.
- Children must be enrolled in Kindergarten or above to attend regular RE classes. We offer classes for all grades and encourage participation before AND after receiving the sacraments.
- For Special Education classes or for RCIA for children or adults, please call the parish or email bmaxwell@saintjudelakewood.org for a registration form.

Sacramental Preparation for baptized Catholics

- Children in grades 2 and 3 who have not yet received the sacrament of reconciliation will be enrolled in "Sac Prep Year 1"* (they will be in Sac Prep Year 2 the following school year).
- Children in grades 3 5 who <u>have</u> received the sacrament of reconciliation and/or the sacrament of Eucharist (1st Communion), but have NOT celebrated Confirmation will be enrolled in "Sac Prep Year 2"*
- For children in 4th and 5th grade who have not received the sacrament of reconciliation, please contact Brenda as soon as possible: bmaxwell@saintjudelakewood.org
- For children in grades 6 12 see schedule information on the Youth registration form. Students will be enrolled in both Youth Group and the Youth Sacramental Prep class.
- * DUE TO CLASSROOM SPACE LIMITATIONS, SACRAMENTAL PREP CLASS SIZES WILL BE LIMITED IF YOU HAVE A STRONG DAY PREFERENCE (WED. OR SUN.), PLEASE PLAN TO REGISTER EARLY!

Registration fees for the 2020 – 2021 year are as follows:

No child will be denied enrollment due to the inability to pay. However, you must contact us, or we have no way of knowing what your needs are. We are happy to work out a payment plan if that helps or may offer scholarships for those families unable to pay at all. Families on scholarship may be asked to provide time and talent to aid our programs.

• Sac Prep (Year 1 or Year 2) Retreat fee \$25 per child (in addition to the \$50 fee)

(At this time, we are not certain if we will be able to hold retreats. If so, we will collect this money then.)

A cap of \$150 per family applies to all classes (retreat fees are additional).

For all children being registered in **Confirmation and Sacramental Preparation** classes: We must have a copy of your **child's Catholic baptismal certificate** with your registration even if your child was baptized at St. Jude.

For Elementary RE classes, please be aware that **email is our primary form of communication**. We generally send out weekly emails to keep you informed of any changes in schedule, upcoming special events, etc. Please provide a valid email address and check it regularly so we can keep you informed about your child's programs. Thank you.
