

A Message from Our Pastor

Image of the unfailing love with which God loves man

I recently had the blessing of being able to celebrate and bless a couple from our parish who just celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary. And I invited them to join me and Tyler to discuss the ups and downs, joys and sorrows of their life together over the past 50 years in our weekly parish podcast. We discussed the importance of the friendship they built before they even started courting, where there is often today a desire just to try and find someone that checks off all the boxes in order to find a mate. This gave them a chance to build a relationship that was more than finding a person to complete the end goal of a large party but someone they could learn to walk with in the joys and struggles of life.

But most importantly in our conversation, we discussed how their marriage is not just something between the two of them, but something that they have strived since the beginning to bring God into so that it is a trinity of persons. And that is truly what a marriage is: "God created him man and woman, their mutual love becomes an image of the absolute and unfailing life with which God loves man" (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1604). A Marriage should be an image of the Trinity of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and be a blessing on their family as well as the community around them. Let us pray for all married couples that they may recognize the need for God to be a part of their unions and that they may have the fortitude to be the image of God's love to the world around them.

Interested in Becoming Catholic?

It is now time to register for St. Jude's RCIA **Program.** Our model of formation provides a form of learning, centered on the relationship of the individual with the person of Jesus Christ and with his body, the Church. It centers catechesis in the primary place where that relationship is fostered and celebrated, in the community of faith that gathers Sunday by Sunday throughout the year. "Within the cycle of the year the Church unfolds the whole mystery of Christ, from his incarnation and birth until his ascension, the day of Pentecost and the expectation of blessed hope and of the Lord's return." This model also respects the journey of each person. It assumes that those who come seeking initiation will be welcomed whenever they arrive, no matter what time of the year that happens to be.

In this model of sacramental catechesis, the Church uses the language of journey, conversion, discipleship and relationship. Rather than a program of specific instruction, the RCIA suggests a fluid, gradual process of formation, the heart of which is the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ.
