

## A Message from Our Pastor

Saints: Busy about the work of God

What a joy it is to be Catholic! Not only do we have the availability to come to the church and receive the body and blood of Christ, but we also are blessed to have the Communion of Saints. If you listened to the most recent parish podcast, you will hear us talk about some of the great Saints that we are celebrating in the Church over the next month. And what a joy it is to be able to celebrate and learn about the lives of these great Saints. They give us a great example to learn from.

The Saints learned during their lives that it is important to live lives not just of making a claim of the title of being a Christian, but rather they realized that their lives were meant to be about the work of God. Even now as they see God face to face and they are about the works of God and desire to intercede for us to Him.

We often reach out to the saints to ask of their intersession not because they are God, but because they are face to face with God and can bring our prayer to Him. When we ask for their intersession, it is not about us asking that our will be done, they aren't meant to be used as a magic way to get everything we want. Rather we are asking that they intercede for use so that we might ultimately do the will of God, even if that is not the desired outcome we are hoping for. I encourage you this week to learn more about some of the great saints we have in the Church and to ask for their intercession in your life. May we learn to live a life similar to theirs by putting God first and become the saints that God has called each of us to be.

## **Interested in Becoming Catholic?**

It is now time to register for St. Jude's RCIA **Program.** Our model of formation provides a form of learning, centered on the relationship of the individual with the person of Jesus Christ and with his body, the Church. It centers catechesis in the primary place where that relationship is fostered and celebrated, in the community of faith that gathers Sunday by Sunday throughout the year. "Within the cycle of the year the Church unfolds the whole mystery of Christ, from his incarnation and birth until his ascension, the day of Pentecost and the expectation of blessed hope and of the Lord's return." This model also respects the journey of each person. It assumes that those who come seeking initiation will be welcomed whenever they arrive, no matter what time of the year that happens to be.

In this model of sacramental catechesis, the Church uses the language of journey, conversion, discipleship and relationship. Rather than a program of specific instruction, the RCIA suggests a fluid, gradual process of formation, the heart of which is the paschal mystery of Jesus Christ.

## Did you know?



In the event of a life threatening issue here at St. Jude, we have installed three defibrillators: one at the bottom of the ramp in the Community Center, one by the south main door in the church, and one in the Youth Center. An AED or Automated External Defibrillator is a portable device that checks the heart rhythm and can send an electric shock to the heart to restore normal rhythm. AED's are used to treat Sudden Cardiac Arrest (SCA). SCA is a condition in which the heart suddenly and unexpectedly stops beating. The AED machine is easy to use and a YouTube video on how to use it may be found at: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=AAz2D8hCCvI
