Happy Feast of St. Jude

We are blessed to be under the patronage of St. Jude Thaddeus and what a joy it was to celebrate our parish feast day last week. Not much is known about him. We do know that he was one of the 12 Apostles; he is believed to have preached the Gospel around Judea and was eventually martyred. His body is now buried in St. Peter's Basilica, and the epistle of Jude in the New Testament is also believed to have been written by him.

What we all seem to know about St. Jude is that he is the patron saint of hopeless causes. We call upon him when all seems lost. And it is good that we call upon this holy saint for his intercession, but we must remind ourselves to not call upon him as a miracle worker that will magically make everything better. Rather we should look to him for his intercession for that cause that may seem hopeless and ask for his intercession that we might be able to see God's plan and find peace no matter how it turns out.

This last week I was going to go see our kids in our RE program and I wanted to bring over to them some holy cards of St. Jude. I went to go grab the cards out of my office, but they were in the middle of cleaning the carpets in the parish office. I was disappointed that I could not bring these holy cards to share our patron with the children of our parish. So, as I walked over, I prayed that St. Jude might help me trust in whatever plan there was in me not being able to bring them over. And sure enough, as I got to the Holy Family House, all the kids already had a holy card of St. Jude that was given to them. It may have not been my plan, but God and St. Jude took care of things even in this simple situation. So let us call out to our patron and all the saints for their intercession this week, not that everything may go the way we want it, but that God's will might be done in our lives.
