A Message from Our Pastor

Not My Will, But Yours be Done

This past weekend we welcomed one of the seminarians studying here in the Archdiocese of Denver for the annual seminary appeal and I want to thank you all for your generosity in giving to the appeal. After all the Masses were over, I was able to sit down with Brian and talk with him on our parish podcast about his own call to the seminary and God's call for each of us in our lives.

In our conversation, he talked about how each day his mom would pray for him, his siblings, and their future spouses and children. In that prayer, she had the intention that it may also mean they might be called to a religious vocation as well and then their spouse and children would look different than what we normally think of.

How beautiful is that prayer? Each one of us is called by God in our own way. And that may not be anything close to what we expect for our lives or what our parents expect for our lives. But if we listen to the words of St. Paul in his letter to the Ephesians, we hear that all of us are called in these different ways for "building up the body of Christ" (Ephesians 4:12). So, we must ask the question, "What is God calling me to?" Not just in a larger vocation, many of you have already followed that call into your marriages, but each day what is God calling you to? Maybe that call is uncomfortable or outside of your own plans. Make that prayer each day, asking God to guide you in His path.

I think one thing that we are all called to each day is to pray for each other as we strive to help build up the body of Christ. Pray that the person sitting next to you at Mass this weekend might know the will of God in their life. Pray for your children, not that they follow the path that you think is best for them, but that they might strive to follow the will of God that makes them the Saint he is calling them to be. And please pray for members of our parish (young or old) to be open to God's call to a religious life or priesthood.
