## A Message from Our Pastor

"Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

Are these words that we hear today from the Gospel from the good thief, not words all of us should cry out? Our desire as Christians is to ultimately be united with Christ in heaven for all eternity. But just desiring to be united with Christ, both now and for all eternity, doesn't mean everything will be easy. Jesus tells us that we must take up our crosses and follow him.

This idea of taking up a cross that is heavy, burdensome, and leads to suffering, is not pleasant. As a human, it is our instinct to avoid that - even Christ who was fully human asked for the Father to take it from Him. But when we take up our cross, we unite ourselves to Christ who we celebrate today as King. We also must remember that these crosses will not last, for they are only of this world. We are called through the pain and sorrow of the crosses of our lives on this earth, to something that is greater and eternal - heaven.

We also must acknowledge that if we desire to unite ourselves to Christ and be with him in heaven that we must also echo the other words of the good thief, St. Dismas, and confess with him that we have been condemned justly for our own sinfulness. We are all sinful and in need of Christ's forgiveness on the cross, but let us not get stuck in that and not allow our King to forgive us. As we celebrate Christ as King this weekend and begin the Advent season next weekend, let us come back to our King and ask him for forgiveness. All of us should partake in the Sacrament of Reconciliation so that we can not only be forgiven, but receive the graces of this great sacrament to help us carry the crosses that we have and one day be united with our King in heaven.

### **Adopt-a-Family Program for Christmas**



#### Sacraments




