





A Message from Our Pastor

Marriage: An Image of the Trinity

"Those who are deemed worthy to attain to the coming age and to the resurrection of the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage." (Lk 20:35)

Although our Gospel reading today says that there is no marriage in Heaven, we can look to marriage now as both a heavenly reality and an example of holiness to follow throughout our earthly lives.

First, marriage isn't simply important to the couple or the children that they might have; each marriage has great importance to all of us in our community. That's because marriage is an image of the Trinity. Whenever we look upon a married couple, we should be reminded of our Triune God. The Trinity is composed of the Father and Son, and from the love of the Father and Son proceeds the Holy Spirit: three Persons, one God. In the same way, there is love between a husband and wife, and from that love proceeds children. This sacrament helps make visible the invisible reality of the Trinity.

Second, marriage is a great gift for growing in holiness. Both spouses have a partner to help them along their own path to Heaven and becoming a saint. Marriage isn't about financial benefits or convenient friendship; marriage is so that you might have a helpmate to encourage you each day to strive for and reach heaven. Husbands and wives are called to help each other live a saintly life.

I encourage all our married couples to recognize the image of the Trinity reflected in their marriage and to let that lead them to work each day to help one another get to heaven. Care for your spouse so that both of you may avoid sin in your lives and become the saints you are called to be.
