 Our Pastor

Here I am, Lord; I come to do your will

As we are now in the liturgical season of Ordinary time, it can be easy to just get back into the mundane and the ordinary parts of our life as well. But this is not a time to take as simply ordinary, we have just finished celebrating part of the greatest gift we have ever been given, the birth of our God become man, and that should change us. This change is not in the new clothes we might have gotten at Christmas or the new routine that we are trying to implement as a part of the new year. But that change should come in our response to the Lord who as the Psalmist says today, we have "waited, waited for the Lord"

Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is known about his life. According to various accounts, he was a physician before becoming a bishop. He was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the

eighth century he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat. We will be blessing throats on his feast day at the **8am Mass on Friday, February 3rd**. The throat blessing will not be repeated at weekend Masses.
