

A Message from Our Pastor

Lent Is Upon Us

Ash Wednesday is just a couple of days away. Maybe you are already prepared for

the Lenten season, or maybe the season snuck up on you this year. No matter how you feel about Lent starting this week, there are a few things I want to impart upon you as we enter this unique liturgical season.

For starters, Lent isn't about making yourself miserable with lots of penances that you struggle to keep each week. Rather, it's about going to a place where you can enter more deeply into a relationship with God. On Ash Wednesday, we will hear Jesus tell us in the Gospel reading that "when you pray, go to your inner room, close the door, and pray to your Father in secret" (Mt 6:6). Maybe you have struggled with spending time in prayer or just acknowledging God in your day-to-day life outside of Mass on Sundays. Let this season of Lent be a time for you to go into that inner room of your heart—and make sure you let God into that room as well. Let Him bring His light to counter the gloom of this world. Find time to spend a little more time in prayer each day.

As you enter that inner room for prayer, remember that this journey of Lent is just that: a journey. You don't need to be at the finish line of perfect communion with God on day one. Allow yourself to grow during the journey of the season so that each week you can go a little deeper in that relationship with God. If you try to accomplish too much in the first week of Lent, you will surely fail. But walk with Jesus during this season and allow Him to walk with you and guide you into a deeper relationship with Him day by day. It may not be easy—it will surely lead to the cross—but on the other side the joy or the resurrection will be all the greater.

Rules for Fasting & Abstinence

Roman Catholics must fast and abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Additionally, they must abstain from meat on all Fridays during Lent. According to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops, the norms of fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. Fasting means a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but they are not to equal that of a full meal. The rule of abstinence from meat is binding upon Catholics aged 14 and onwards.


