



A Message from Our Pastor

Jesus, I trust in You

I hope you and your families have had a blessed start to this joyous Easter season. On

this second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. It truly is a blessing to celebrate this special solemnity of God's mercy, especially since it is one we have only been celebrating officially for 20 years.

But what is it that we are celebrating on this Divine Mercy Sunday? The feast we commemorate originates from the visions St. Faustina had with our Lord, in which He asked her to paint an image of His merciful heart (you can see this image on the wall of our church near the sacristy door). Our Lord also asked to establish this day as a devotion to His Divine Mercy, that we might take refuge in Him.

I want us to reflect on the idea of taking refuge in Jesus' mercy. We just celebrated the holiest days of the year with the Triduum and Easter—and then we all headed back to our normal, day-to-day lives. Entering back into the world can leave us anxious, stressed, and lost. But we do not need to be alone and isolated as we enter back into the world's everyday circumstances. Our Lord is with us, and no matter our struggles, He wants us to trust in Him and His mercy. You will notice at the bottom of the Divine Mercy image the words "Jesus, I Trust in You." When we take refuge in His Divine Mercy, we tell Jesus that we trust in Him. We let Jesus take on our worries, anxieties, and fears, and we entrust ourselves to His love and mercy for us.

I leave you with a quote from Pope St. John Paul II, who instituted this feast 20 years ago: "Those who sincerely say 'Jesus, I trust in You' will find comfort in all their anxieties and fears."






