


Bible Mini-Series Continues

A Message from Our Pastor

Abundant Life

How beautiful this time of year is as life begins to sprout anew! The rain and sun come out more, so that the natural world may bloom around us. What a joy it is to see this life and color! This life sprouting forth is a reminder of the new life that has been given to us this Easter season. Christ came, died, and then rose from the dead to give us new life. Do we accept that offer of new life?
