

A Message from Our Pastor

Christ My Hope Is Risen!

We are here today to celebrate one thing: an empty tomb. Our Lenten

journey of fasting and penance led us all the way up to the cross, where the Son of God died a criminal's death . . . but Easter marks the defeat of death.

Christ is risen! Christ our hope is alive!

Christ truly is our hope—and it is this hope that I want us to dwell on. We just spent 40 days on a Lenten journey of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Maybe Lent wasn't a problem for you—or maybe it was a real struggle. Maybe you nailed every one of your Lenten sacrifices—or maybe you failed every single day of Lent with keeping them. This is a reminder of how life can be for us. There are times when everything seems easy, and it seems impossible for anything to go wrong; there are also times for all of us when everything seems to go wrong, and every day ends with exhaustion and a sense of feeling lost. Wherever you are on this life's journey, I want you to know three things. You are welcome. You are not alone. And there is HOPE.

Today, I encourage you: Let us take Christ's outstretched hand and allow Him to guide us away from the darkness of the grave so that we can come into the light of this new life. And let us also remember to reach out to those who are still in darkness. We are a community that is called to walk together and help each other. Let us continue the journey together with Christ, our greatest hope, who has today risen from the dead! He is truly risen! Alleluia, alleluia!


Fellowship of Light






