A Message from Our Pastor

Happy Mothers Day!

A happy Mother's Day to all mothers, both biological and spiritual, in our parish today. In honor of our mothers, I want to share with you part of a homily from Pope St. John Paul II when he beatified two holy women, St. Gianna Beretta Molla and Blessed Elisabetta Canori Mora:

"Motherhood can be a source of joy, but it can also become a source of suffering, and sometimes of great disappointments. In this case, love becomes a test, not infrequently a heroic one, which costs a lot to a mother's heart.

"How extraordinary is their participation in the care of the Good Shepherd at times! How much they have to struggle against difficulties and dangers! How many times are they called to face authentic 'wolves,' determined to take away and scatter the flock! And these heroic mothers do not always find support in their environment. Indeed, the models of civilization, often promoted and propagated by the media, do not favor motherhood. In the name of progress and modernity, the values of fidelity, chastity and sacrifice are presented as outdated, in which hosts of Christian wives and mothers have distinguished themselves and continue to distinguish themselves." (John Paul II, Homily, 24 April 1994)

We are blessed with many mothers in our parish who have given so much of themselves to lead us to an encounter with our Good Shepherd, whom we talked about only a couple of Sundays ago. But that guidance from them in the face of a culture that often opposes them can become taxing and difficult. So, as we celebrate our mothers today, I encourage you to go beyond just getting them some flowers. Spend some intentional time in prayer and maybe even fasting for your mothers (biological or spiritual mothers, those who are still with us on earth or those who have passed on), that they may be consoled by our Lord and our Blessed Mother and have the courage to continue to care for us and guide us to our Good Shepherd.



Curtis Martin appointed by Pope Francis to the Dicastery for Evangelization

Curtis Martin, who came to St. Jude with his wife Michaelann for this year's Lenten Mission, has been appointed by Pope Francis to serve as a consultor to the Dicastery for Evangelization.

A dicastery is a department within the Roman Curia which helps the Pope carry out the administration of the universal church. There are 16 dicasteries in the Curia. Pope Francis has reorganized the Curia and the Dicastery for Evangelization was established in 2022 saying that it "serves the work of evangelization, so that Christ, the light of the nations, may be known and witnessed to by word and deed, and the Church, his mystical Body, may be built up."

"I'm thrilled to be invited to serve in this capacity and serve the Church in an even broader way," Martin told CNA Wednesday. He said the dicastery helps serve the pope and other Vatican leaders and is an opportunity "to listen to others and to give feedback and share best practices. Read the whole article at:




