A Message from Our Pastor

But They Doubted

We live in a world that can at times be depressing and lead

us to doubt that our God is even present. Even the disciples felt this way when Jesus, who had recently died and risen from the dead, was before them. We hear in today's Gospel that, while Jesus was before them, "they worshiped, but they doubted." You yourself might leave the Church today, after worshipping and receiving Jesus who is truly present in the Eucharist, and enter back into the world only to feel doubts. You are not alone.

We face a world that is increasingly at odds with each other and at odds with our faith. That leads us to sometimes wonder: "Where are you, God? Why aren't you present?" But He is always with us, so long as we allow Him into our lives. Even the disciples came to realize this after Jesus ascended into heaven. In the most difficult moments, when all hope is lost, it is then that we must turn to Jesus and say, "I trust in You." We are not created to be alone and completely self-sufficient; we are created to live in community together and to place our trust in God, for "the Lord is our strength" (Ps 28:7).

As we are commissioned to go forth this week at the end of Mass, just as the disciples are commissioned in today's Gospel, remember that you are not alone in your struggles, doubts, and fears. Even the disciples doubted when standing face-to-face with Jesus, so we can expect to have moments of doubt. But let us look past those moments and place our trust in Jesus, allowing Him to be our strength when all seems lost.


