

A Message from Our Pastor

Happy Birthday, Church!

Happy Pentecost and happy birthday to Holy Mother Church! Today we observe a wonderful celebration in the Solemnity of Pentecost as we commemorate the beginning of the Church when the Holy Spirit descended and came to rest on the Apostles. This coming of the Holy Spirit was promised by Jesus before He ascended into heaven and today is the fulfillment of that promise.

What a relief the Apostles must have felt when the Holy Spirit came upon them! Often in our own lives, we have something that we are waiting for, either out of hopeful expectation or because it was promised to us. The joy and peace that comes when that thing we are longing and waiting for arrives is so great, and it can even feel like a weight off our shoulders. I am sure the same was true for the Apostles on Pentecost—but they didn't just sit there because the Spirit had finally come upon them. Rather, they went out immediately and started preaching the message of Christ and working towards the mission He had sent them on.

The peace that they felt upon receiving the Holy Spirit was also purifying for them. The Spirit came as tongues of fire, and fire can be used to purify things. The Spirit purified them of their doubt, fear, and concern of being without Jesus so that they could enter into the world preaching the good news about Him.

Let us celebrate the start of the Church on Pentecost today. May we remember our own sacrament of confirmation, and then head out into our world, purified by the Spirit, to share the peace and joy of Jesus.
