


Eucharist. Every Friday we will also have the Chaplet of Divine Mercy at 3:00 pm.

#### A Message from Our Pastor

#### Mary's Month

In the Church, the month of May is when we honor Mary, the mother of God. What a wonderful time of year, as the days get longer and the flowers and trees begin to bloom, to

celebrate the new Eve who said "yes" to God and allowed His plan for our redemption to come about through her. We don't honor Mary as equal to God; rather, we honor her for all the work she does to point us to her Son, who is God.

In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus tell His disciples that He is the way, the truth, and the life—and that it is only through Him that we can go to the Father. If we want to gain heaven, it is only through living out the truth of our faith and proclaiming Christ. So why should we look to Mary? Because she will always lead us to her Son. When studying Mary in sacred art and statuary, she is usually looking or pointing to Jesus. She points to the infant Jesus in her arms, or to her Son on the cross, or to the tabernacle in the Church where Jesus resides in the Eucharist. Like all good mothers, Mary takes us by the hand and patiently walks us to the thing we need most. We honor Mary because of her "yes" and because she helps us say "yes" to God as well.

What can you do this month to honor Mary? Here at the parish, some of our children will come forward and crown Mary at the beginning of Mass. You can do the same thing in your own home: create a little crown and place it on top of a statue of Mary if you have one, or place flowers in front of an image of Mary. You can also pray the Rosary more often during this month, meditating on the mysteries of Jesus' life. This may mean you pick up your rosary beads for the first time in years and pray once a week; if you are already praying a Rosary every day, then you could consider saying an extra one each week. Whatever you do, make sure to spend time this month honoring the woman who wants nothing more than to lead us to her Son, who is the way, the truth, and the life.
