#### A Message from Our Pastor

#### What is a Sequence?

You may have noticed a couple of times over the past few weeks that we have had something a little different in our Mass order. After we

listen to the proclamation of the second reading, we typically stand up for the Alleluia and the Gospel reading, but this weekend and back on Pentecost, there was something else that we recited in between them, a Sequence.

What are these sequences? They are ancient poetry and this weekend's sequence was written by St. Thomas Aquinas. Over the years, many of the sequences that used to be in the Missal for Mass have been taken out, but some of them were said to be too beautiful to be left out and so some of them continue to be in our liturgy to this day. These ancient poems were originally written in Latin, so in translation they lose a little of their poetic beauty, but nevertheless they lead us into a deeper reflection on the mysteries of our faith.

This weekend's sequence is in honor of our solemnity today, Corpus Christi, the celebration of the Body and Blood of Christ. We give honor and worship to our Lord in the reception of His Body and Blood this weekend. And with that I want to challenge you to do two things this week. First, I want you to reflect on what it means to receive the Eucharist this weekend. When we receive the Eucharist, we allow Jesus to be with us and we become as Christ-bearers, like Mary for those nine months she was pregnant. We are carrying Jesus with us, and therefore we should go forth and bear the light of Christ in our everyday life at home, work, or even the grocery store. Secondly, I encourage you to look up the words of this Sunday's sequence and spend a little time in prayer with it, even if it is just a couple stanzas. Allow these beautiful words of St. Thomas Aquinas to lead you into a greater reflection on our faith and on the Eucharist.
