



# Jesus' Heart Was Moved with Pity

I am excited because my favorite season of the year starts this week. I love summer. Being from Arizona, for me summer is a time to enjoy the outdoors, sun, vacations, and people getting together. But as I reflect on today's Gospel, I have to wonder how Jesus' heart would be moved if He saw the people in our society today as they walk around the city, gather for different events (sports, concerts, championship parades), or enjoy a gathering of friends for a BBQ. I think His heart might be moved with pity—because, despite the joy and goodness of the different things we might be doing as we enjoy this wonderful season (or any season for that matter), many in our society go about their daily activities troubled and feeling alone and abandoned.

As our archbishop has said many times recently, we are no longer living in a time of Christendom; we are now in a new apostolic age. Today's Gospel reading is a summons for all of us who live in this society to realize that our Lord's heart is moved with pity for the people He sees who are troubled, like sheep without a Shepherd. We are called to recognize that there is an abundant harvest in front of us and that we must ask the Lord to send out laborers for the harvest. We must also ask for the guidance of the Holy Spirit to know how He is calling us to be a laborer in this abundant harvest of a society that has no Shepherd. Without cost we have received great things from our faith; now, without cost, we must go forth and share our faith with others.

#### **Knight of the Month April 2023**


