A Message from Our Pastor

Father, Son, and Holy Spirit

The Easter season has ended, and we are now in Ordinary Time.

Still, this Sunday the Church gives us something special to celebrate and reminds us that, even when life feels ordinary, life in the Church is anything but ordinary. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity—which puts special focus on God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As we focus on the Trinity, we must remember that we do not confess three gods, but One, who is Triune. In the words of the *Catechism*, "The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire" (CCC 253). We must look to our God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in our daily lives to guide us.

Now I have a question for you. When you pray, to whom do you pray? I would be willing to say most of us aim our prayers to God the Father or God the Son, meaning we often leave the Holy Spirit out. I instead encourage you to consider praying to the Holy Spirit. When Jesus ascended into heaven, He said He would not leave us orphans but would send us an Advocate. That Advocate is the Holy Spirit who guides the Church; we should therefore allow the Holy Spirit to guide us in our daily journey. The Holy Spirit is there to inspire us just as He inspired the Scripture authors. The Holy Spirit is there to lead us on our journey, even when it may be difficult (the same way He led Jesus into the desert). Consider starting each day praying for the Holy Spirit to guide you to do God's holy will in your life. That prayer can be the Holy Spirit Prayer, which I leave you with today:

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth. Amen.


