

Vacation Bible School Shines Jesus' Light!


Thank you to the many volunteers who donated their time, talents, and treasures in

Pastor's Blog

Blessed Stanley Rother: Pray for Us!

Last Sunday I shared my

experience of making a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Blessed Stanley Rother in Oklahoma City. Here, I want to share three lessons which can be gleaned from the life of Blessed Stanley Rother. They can be referred to as the three "L's" of his saintly life: Learn; Love; Leave!

Learn: It has been observed that Blessed Stanley Rother was an auditory learner rather than a visual learner. He quickly grasped the language of the native Mayans of Guatemala whom he served in the 1970's and 1980's by listening to them. This brilliance flies in juxtaposition to his seminary training where he struggled to pass the exams based on textbook materials, which is visual learning. Assumption Seminary in San Antonio has the unfortunate notoriety of failing the only saint that enrolled for formation! He was ordained after acquiring new learning techniques which allowed him to pass.

Love: All parish priests love the people of their flocks, but Blessed Stanley Rother proved his love by remaining with them even when his life was threatened. His people were being threatened by the communists. When they threatened Father Rother's life and demanded that he return to the United States, he chose to remain with his people.

Leave: This priest experienced a martyr's death in his parish rectory on July 28, 1981. Every pastor has to leave his parish when divine Providence dictates. Blessed Stanley Rother departure from his parish was dictated when paramilitary operators shot him.

St Jude Special Education Program

Our Special Ed program is designed to help the developmentally disabled learn about Jesus & the

Catholic faith. We instruct the students in the faith to allow them to celebrate the Sacraments and we prepare them for Christian living in today's world. The class is designed to meet the needs of each student individually and we try to maintain a 1:1 or 1:2 teacher/student ratio. Materials are individualized for each student depending on their learning needs and their level of understanding.

Students that have received all their Sacraments read the Sunday Gospel for the week while others choose to study the saints, learn the Rosary, or explore other topics.

Each class starts with all students and teachers sharing what they would like to pray for, followed by the entire group saying the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Glory Be. The group then divides into individual classes or one-onone time to go over the current lesson. Mass is celebrated monthly with Fr. Roland Freeman during our class time. Sacraments

Baptisms: A pre-baptismal session is required for parents and godparents. Please call the office at 303-988-6435 before or after the child's birth, before you choose godparents, to register. **The next class is July 29th from 9am-12pm** in the Community Center lower level.




