

Pastor's Blog

Who is Jesus?

Who do you say that the Son of Man is? The question of the identity of Jesus Christ is fundamental to our identity as Catholics. The answer to the question, of course, is that He is "the Son of the living God."

The answer which Peter offers affirms the divinity of Jesus. In Jewish culture, the son would inherit all from the father. This inheritance includes not only material goods but also the honor and status. By affirming that Jesus is the Son of the living God Peter is affirming that Jesus is God.

The fact that Jesus begins by referring to himself as the "Son of Man" gave his listeners a hint about the correct answer to his question. In the book of the prophet Isiah, the prophet proclaims that the messiah would come as the "Son of man" with great power.

Peter offers his proclamation in the divinity of Christ just like Saint Paul did. In his letter to the Galatians, Saint Paul says, "when He who had set me apart before I was born and had called me through his grace, was pleased to reveal His Son to me" (1:15 emphasis added) Thus, Saint Paul affirms the divinity of Jesus.

The identity of Jesus creates the foundation of our faith. You could think of His divinity as the hardware of your spiritual life. With this basis of knowing Who we worship, all of the rest of our human activity is able to function properly. That remainder of our human activity could be liked to the software of our lives.






