# **Pastor's Blog**

# Let's Travel Together

If you presumed from the title of this blog that I am

promoting the Holy Land Pilgrimage in this space, you would be mistaken! Instead, I want to explain the synod. On October 4th the universal church will host a synod on synodality. The word synod from two Greek words which were put together: travel (hodos) and together (syn). The pope or bishops will occasionally call a synod when they want to hear about a topic in the church before teaching about it. The word implies that the bishop's focus in the teaching would change (or travel) in order to be together with the members of the faithful. For example, if a bishop was about to give a pastoral letter on ways to improve marriage preparation, he might call a synod of married couples, psychologists, and sociologists before writing the letter.

Pope Francis has placed a special emphasis on the role of synods in his papacy. He said, "From the beginning of my ministry as Bishop of Rome, I sought to enhance the synod, which is one of the most precious legacies of the Second Vatican Council. We must continue along this path." These words which he gave in a speech on October 17th of 2015 show the important role which Pope Francis gives to synodality.

Next month's synod has been titled a "Synod on Synodality." It is anticipated that the participants will create a final document. Pope Francis will then either write his own response or sign the final document which would give it the weight of the successor of Peter.


### KNIGHT OF THE MONTH, JULY 2023 BROTHER WILLIAM (BILL) KENNEDY


