Altar Server Training



Pastor's Blog

Forgive Your Brother

Today's gospel motivates us to forgive those who have done us wrong. Why should

we forgive them? We forgive them because we have been forgiven by God through the blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ. In this regard, the universalists have done us a disservice. Universalism is the belief that everyone goes to heaven. While the position that we should hope that everyone would go to heaven is praiseworthy, the effects of presumption distort the gospel. If everyone goes to heaven no matter what they do, then the forgiveness of any of our sins is nonconsequential. Without a sense of needing a savior and redemption, we lose gratitude for what we have received. If we have no need to be forgiven, we have no need to forgive our neighbor.

But clearly our Lord Jesus Christ does want us to appreciate our salvation. We have been saved by the great sacrifice of the life of the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. As redeemed Christians, we have a sense of the expensive and extravagance of our salvation. Then, we should likewise make great sacrifices to forgive others who have done wrong to us. This is the message of today's Gospel: your salvation is worthy of gratitude. We show that gratitude by forgiving others.

If you find yourself struggling to find a reason to forgive others, then I suggest that you spend time studying the crucifix. When we know how hard won our salvation is, we find internal strength to forgive our brothers.
