



Pastor's Blog

Updates from the Synod

The pope has called for a Synod on Synodality. While many have offered

their concerns about who has been selected to serve as representatives at the synod which is currently taking place in Rome, there has not been any official statements from the participants on their outcomes. In the midst of these concerns, our former archbishop, Archbishop Charles Chaput, has offered this observation, "It's the task of the delegate to remember that the Church belongs to Jesus Christ; she is his Church first." (First Things 10/6) Every Christian, especially those appointed to serve at the synod, should labor to help the Church to be more faithful and to explain what faithfulness looks like with clarity.

As the synod continues into November, I invite you to remember that Jesus is the prince of peace. When there are disturbances to your peace, I invite you to consider if Jesus has been pushed out of the center of your heart. If the synod has you concerned, I remind you to remember your identity as a beloved son/ daughter of God. Saint Paul said it most perfectly, "What can separate us from the love of Christ?"

Finally, Bishop Barron reassures us, "prayer has been a major component of this synod. The General Assembly was preceded by a three-day spiritual retreat. Additionally, the synod's meetings begin with morning prayer each day around 8:45 a.m., and there are times for prayer during the small group discussions as well." (Wordonfire.org)
