

## **Pastor's Blog**

# **Shrines of the Holy Land: Part 2**

Today we continue our three-part series on the Shrines of the Holy Land.

Here, I offer a study of the Church of the Annunciation. The shrine marks the site where the Archangel Gabriel announced to the Blessed Virgin Mary that she would be the mother of Jesus.

The massive two-story basilica, in strikingly modern architectural style and colorfully decorated, became the largest Christian church in the Middle East when it was completed in 1969. It contains two churches, the upper one being the parish church for Nazareth's Catholic community. You enter the church from the west, which symbolizes the life of the Christians. As the predominant Christian populations throughout the ages was in Western Civilization, Christians would look to the East for their salvation. This has been traditionally symbolized in Catholic cemeteries where the dead are buried such that, when they would sit up at the resurrection, they would face the east. As one enters the Church of the Annunciation, a statue of Mary greets the visitor. She is depicted as being very young, about 14 years old, to match her age at the time of the annunciation. The lower level of the Church of the Annunciation enshrines a sunken grotto that contains the traditional cave-home of the Virgin Mary. The cave is flanked by remnants of earlier churches on the site. The purpose of the new church above the ancient shrine is twofold: the symbolism of the Church today being founded on the cooperation of the Blessed Virgin Mary is preserved and the lower-level shrine is protected from damage from erosion or earthquakes by constructing the building in three separate sections of reinforced concrete. 


