

Pastor's Blog

Pray for Souls in Purgatory

November is customarily the month to pray for souls in Purgatory. We all know of souls who died in a state in which they were not purified enough for heaven, but they were not evil enough to merit eternity in hell. Pope Benedict XVI once quipped that if purgatory were not revealed to us by God, the Church would need to invent the teaching of Purgatory. The scriptures speak of such a place of purification after death in the Second Book of Maccabees. Judas, an Old Testament warrior, prayed for the fallen soldiers who died with idols in their packs. We read that "he made atonement for the dead, that they might be delivered from their sin." (12:46). Saint John Chrysostom said in a homily, "If Job's sons were purified by their father's sacrifice, why would we doubt that our offerings for the dead bring them some consolation? Let us not hesitate to help those who have died and to offer our prayers for them."

Here at Saint Jude Parish, we have the custom of offering a novena of Masses for our deceased loved ones. For nine days, we collectively offer Masses specifically for beloved friends and family members who might be in Purgatory. You can join the novena even after it began on November 2nd and still have the soul receive some benefit of your sacrifice and Masses. To enroll a soul in the All Souls Novena, use an All Souls Day envelope.


Adult Faith Refresher




