Pastor's Blog

This Is My Body: Part 1

Merry Christmas in Advent! As you know, we do not put Christmas in Advent, but I want to

give you your Christmas present early. Each year the parish has the tradition of giving a book to everyone at Christmas. On the First Sunday of Advent, December 3rd, you will receive your Christmas book. The book is called "This Is My Body" by Bishop Robert Barron. It is a spiritual reflection on the gift of the Eucharist and I want us to read it together in Advent. This will enable you to read along with your brothers and sisters as we reflect on the contents of the book. The book has three chapters and the Advent Sunday homilies will correspond to the chapters. The First Sunday of Advent's homily will reflect on the first chapter, the Second Sunday of Advent will reflect on the second chapter, and the Third Sunday of Advent's homily will reflect on the third chapter. Since the Fourth Sunday of Advent falls on Christmas Eve Day, we will have a simple summary homily on that day.

Today I initiate a two-part series in my pastor's blog on the Eucharist using Bishop Barron's book. My intent is to give you an appetizer and make you ready to receive your book on Sunday, December 3rd. For now, consider these words from Bishop Barron's book, "When the communicant says, 'Amen' and receives the proffered host and chalice, he'd better be prepared to live an eternal life." (110)






