



### Pastor's Blog

## Padre Pio Leads to Conversion

I often feel inspired by

conversion stories. The news from the entertainment world was especially inspiring recently. Hollywood star Shia LaBeouf recently formally converted to Catholicism. The 37-yearold actor officially joined the Catholic Church at the end of January, when he received the Sacrament of Confirmation at Old Mission Santa Inés Parish in Solvang, California. Bishop Robert Barron, who wrote our Advent book "The Body of Christ" was the bishop who gave Shia the Sacrament of Confirmation and welcomed him into the Catholic church.

It has been recorded that Shia LaBeouf first began entertaining the idea of converting to Catholicism while working the movie about Padre Pio. Since then, Shia LaBeouf has been outspoken about the way that portraying Padre Pio has affected his soul and led him into the Catholic church. LaBeouf said in an interview with Bishop Barron that he was never an atheist but was instead agnostic. He credits the intercession of Saint Pio of Pietrelcina for reinvigorating his interest in things of faith. Since Padre Pio was a Capuchin Franciscan, Shia is likewise attracted to living a life in imitation of Saint Francis of Assisi. In a post on X, the Capuchin's tweeted that they were "thrilled to share that our dear friend Shia LaBeouf has fully entered the Church this past weekend... The Capuchin Franciscan friars are overjoyed to welcome him into the fold and witness his deep commitment to his faith journey." The post concludes that Shia requests our prayers as he continues to deepen his faith and seek God's guidance in his life.
