### Pastor's Blog

## The 12 Apostles

In today's gospel, Our Lord calls Simon-Peter, Andrew, James, and John to follow him. It can be speculated that Andrew, Simon-Peter, and John had returned to their work as fishermen after last Sunday's gospel when they were first introduced to Jesus by John the Baptist. Today's gospel gives us our first liturgical introduction to Saint James.

The call of these primary apostles gives us the opportunity to review the names of the 12 apostles. Can you recite them by heart? In Eucharistic Prayer number 1, the list of how the Catholic Church refers to the 12 apostles is authoritative. So, to memorize their names use those names and that order. They are: **Peter; Andrew; James; John; Thomas; James; Philip; Bartholomew; Matthew; Simon and Jude.** The twelfth and final member, Judas Iscariot, is not mentioned since it can be speculated that he is in hell. There were two Saint Jameses who served Our Lord as apostles. We distinguish them using the suffixes of "the greater" for the first one and "the lesser" for the second one. The apostle called in the gospel today is Saint James the Greater. The Feast of Saint James the Greater is observed annually on July 25<sup>th</sup>. He is the brother of Saint John the Evangelist, gave up his work in his father's fishing business to be a disciple, and is a witness to the Transfiguration. He preached in Spain, but when he returned to Jerusalem in 44 AD, he was martyred.

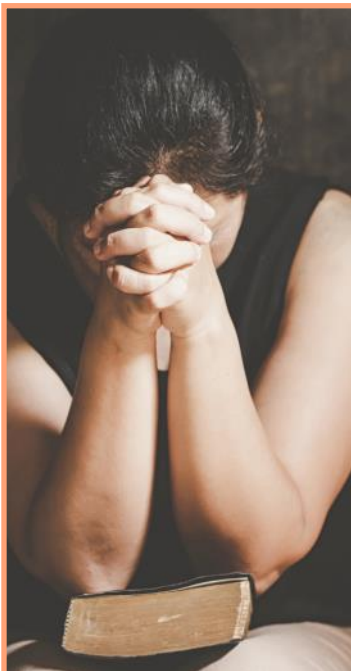
