



Pastor's Blog

The Eucharist: Part 2

This is the second installment in the two-part series on the Eucharist. As part of the parish portion of the year of Eucharistic Revival, I invite you to consider the beauty of Jesus' body and blood in the Eucharist. I hope that you will consider attending the parish mission next week on the Eucharist and to participate in Eucharistic adoration on Friday. Now, I invite you to consider the beauty of the gift of this sacrament which Vatican II calls the source and summit of our faith. (SC #10)

As a meditation on the beauty of the worship of God in the Eucharist, consider the words that the priest sings or says after the consecration: "Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever." For me as a priest, this moment in the Mass consistently fills me with a sense of awe, joy and unworthiness. That moment of worshiping God is matched by the call to love our neighbors. When we offer the general intercessions (those prayers in which we sing "Lord, hear our prayer") we unite in praying for the needs of the world. These prayers make it clear that our presence in the church is not just about ourselves, but instead we pray for the needs of the poor, the nations of the world and, indeed, for the entire Catholic Church. The Eucharist is beautiful because it unites us through God!


