




Children's Liturgy of the Word during the 11 am Mass

Pastor's Blog

Our Lady of Guadalupe

Divine Providence has redirected our parish pilgrimage from the Holy Land to Mexico. I rejoice

that I will be able to return to Our Lady of Guadalupe to give thanks for the gift of my diocesan priesthood in the Archdiocese of Denver! I invite you to consider accompanying me on this pilgrimage. A brochure is included in this week's bulletin with details about our trip.

There are three reasons I think you should consider making this pilgrimage with the rest of us. First, it is customary to make a pilgrimage as Lenten penance. Throughout the ages, pilgrimages to holy sites have been a means to atone for sins. Secondly, I will be celebrating my 25th anniversary of ordination to the priesthood in June. This pilgrimage is the way that I have chosen to celebrate my anniversary and I want you, as a member of the parish, to celebrate it with me! Finally, we grow in faith on our pilgrimages. Not only will you have a devotion to Mary, under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, following this trip. You will also come to admire and ask for the intercession of the "Cristeros." These saintly Catholics continued to practice their faith when a persecution broke out in Mexico in the 1920's. For example, we will visit a shrine devoted to Saint Jose Sanchez del Rio, who is the youngest of the Cristero martyrs. The prayer of a child is powerful and you will experience his intercession! Please consider registering for our pilgrimage.


