





Pastor's Blog

The Eucharist: Part 1

Jesus Christ is truly present in the Holy Eucharist. We have been taught since we were little children that He is truly given to us when we receive Holy Communion at Mass. This is first of a two-part series on the Eucharist which I offer in these Pastor's Blogs.

We are deep into the year of Eucharistic Revival for parishes. The United States bishops have asked all parishes to program events for renewal of devotion to the Eucharistic. Two events are approaching this Lent which give opportunities to grow in our love for the Eucharist. First, we will have a parish mission which will have as its theme "Do this in memory of me." The mission will be preached at 6:30 pm on Sunday, February 18th and Monday, February 19th. Secondly, we will have Eucharistic adoration every Friday of Lent. Our adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will begin after morning Mass and end with benediction before the Stations of the Cross. Adoration will be done in silence except during the recitation of the Holy Rosary after Mass and when the Chaplet of Divine Mercy is prayed at 3:00 pm. For me, as a priest, I find strength, joy, and a call to deeper conversion in the Eucharist. Consider it: God wants to be with us, and He waits for my command to come upon our altar! I must be the luckiest man on the planet!




