



Pastor's Blog

Why Attend the Parish Mission

As you know, the Saint Jude Parish Mission begins

this evening (Sunday, February 18th). I recognize that there are many demands upon your time, so I feel the need to justify the importance of making the sacrifices necessary to attend this event. As a reminder, the parish mission begins at 6:30 pm on both Sunday and Monday evenings in the church.

I identify three reasons that you should participate in this year's parish mission: your spiritual development; your Lenten observance; and to gain a plenary indulgence. We should use our free will to develop and form our souls. Participating in a Lenten mission provides an opportunity to grow in our union with God, which is the goal of our lives! If we are at the same place today in our spiritual lives that we have been for the past years, then we have regressed. God designed the spiritual life for growth. Secondly, it is customary to participate in a mission as a way of observing Lent. If you come to both nights of the parish mission and make a good confession, then I would say that you deserve an 80% on your Lenten practice for this year! Finally, the Church grants a plenary indulgence to souls who listen to a parish mission. Combined with going to confession & Mass and then praying for the intentions of the pope, a soul gains the graces defined by the Church as a plenary indulgence.
