Welcome Reception for New Catholic Members!



Pastor's Blog

God or Man?

The question became common during the period of Soviet expansion in the last century. To ask, "God or

man" solicited a response of either Godly affirmation or mere secular humanism. In his book, "Witness", Whittaker Chambers describes his conversion from being a spy for the communist party to a life of freedom in rural Maryland. He says that he shifted from the response of man to God through studying his baby daughter's ear. Chambers concluded that this beautiful creation implied God the creator.

On this Easter Sunday, we are presented with the same question as we approach the empty tomb. Is the absence of Jesus' body the work of God or the work of man? Did Jesus rise by the power of the Father or is this a result of human trickery? For there to be power in the celebration of Easter and a reason for rejoicing in the resurrection, we must affirm that Easter is a divinely instituted occasion. When we say, "Happy Easter" to someone we must be issuing a blessing upon them which comes from God Himself. Otherwise, our "Happy Easter" greeting becomes a shallow wish of niceness from one human to another, something the equivalent of saying "stay warm and well fed." I assure you: this day is gift from God for which we will celebrate with joy for all eternity! On behalf of myself and all the clergy of Saint Jude Parish, you are greeted with an authentic and holy HAPPY EASTER!




