





Pastor's Blog

Divine Mercy Sunday

This Second Sunday of Easter is also called Divine

Mercy. The devotion to Divine Mercy comes from a series of apparitions which Jesus gave to a nun in Krakow, Poland, in the 1930's. In the apparitions, Jesus asked Saint Faustina to spread devotion to His mercy throughout the world.

Imagine the state of the human soul following World War I, particularly in Poland: the effects of war had saddened the human spirit; German and Russian forces had dominated Poland; and people felt bondage. Amid this sad scene, God intervened with messages of mercy. This awakens hope for the people after World War I, but not some material comfort or even a promise of freedom from adversity. They are to hope through trust in God. The message of the Divine Mercy devotion provides an enthusiastic "yes" to the mercy of God. The banner on the bottom of the Divine Mercy image reads "Jesus, I Trust in You." Trusting in Jesus will bring us to cooperate with His will. That divine will is for our salvation! Our hope, just as it was the hope for people after World War I, is to find solace in the will of God and to trust Him. Trusting in God, Who will deliver us from all sin, is at the heart of the devotion to Divine Mercy. Indeed, trusting that Jesus will save us is at the center of salvation history! The devotion to Divine Mercy merely continues the story of God's work to save us through the Son.
