



## **Our Lady of Guadalupe**

The month of May is devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Divine

Providence has allowed me to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe as I celebrate my 25th anniversary of ordination these days. In just over a week, I will travel to Mexico City with chosen parishioners to engage in the celebration. As we honor Mary this month, I want to offer a special space in my heart and in this pastor's blog to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe.

The Mother of God received the news of the salvation of the world through an apparition. The Archangel Gabriel was visible and audible to Mary in her home at Nazareth. Throughout the life of the Church, Mary has made herself visible and audible to mystics for the upbuilding of the Body of Christ. One such apparition took place in Mexico City in 1531. The account of the apparition of Our Lady of Guadalupe can be summarized as follows: 57-yearold Juan Diego was on his way to Mass when he had a mystical experience and a lady spoke to him; she asked him to approach the bishop and request that a church be built on this pagan site; the bishop asked Juan Diego for a sign; Juan's uncle became seriously ill and the lady assured them of healing; Juan was to pick roses and carry them to the bishop as a sign; and finally when Juan Diego opened his tilma the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was present on his tilma.
