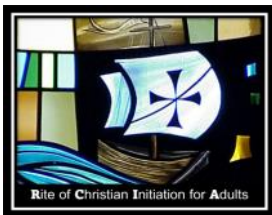
## Visiting Choir for Pentecost

## Pastor's Blog

### The Solemnity of Pentecost

For hundreds of years the Church would number its Sundays based upon Pentecost. Today we use

the expression "ordinary time" and begin numbering our Sundays after the Christmas season. The word "ordinary" comes from "ordo" which means calendar. At the Counsel of Trent, however, the numbering used Pentecost as the reference point and next Sunday would be the "First Sunday after Pentecost."

Why did the Church place such an emphasis on Pentecost? The answer can be seen in Saint Peter's bold proclamation of Jesus Christ after he received the Holy Spirit. The first pope proclaimed, "This Jesus God raised up, and of that we all are witnesses. Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this which you see and hear." (RSV Acts 2:32-33) After Saint Peter received the Holy Spirit, he boldly proclaimed the faith. The effects were amazing: three thousand persons were baptized! These newly baptized devoted themselves to "the apostles teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to the prayers." (Acts 2:42) You should see in these four marks of the early Church's worship the elements of the Mass. We listen to the apostles' teaching in the Liturgy of the Word, we experience fellowship in the community, we have the breaking of the bread in the Eucharist, and we offer our prayers in the general intercessions. We live Pentecost every Sunday!

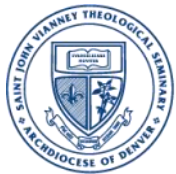
