Pastor's Blog

On 25 Years of Priesthood

Someone asked me what the secret was to get to 25 years of priesthood.



The answer is that the priest resolves to serve Jesus Christ each morning as he wakes up. If you live enough such days, it adds up to 25 years! We should celebrate! While we just got back from the pilgrimage to Mexico to celebrate the June 5th anniversary of my ordination, I am the type of person who celebrates throughout the year. People are proposing that we have an event here at Saint Jude Parish in October to continue my silver jubilee celebration.

May I offer some ordination memories in this blog to help you to thank God with me? The ordination rite contains two moments which are worth reflecting upon. The first comes when the bishop announces to the assembled community, "We choose these men for the order of sacred priesthood." There is always applause from the people in the cathedral at that moment. The applause is an expression of joy that the Holy Spirit is at work to call some to radically abandon themselves for the service of God. The second moment worth contemplation is the prostration. While the people of God sing the Litany of Saints, the candidate for the priesthood lies flat on his face in the cathedral sanctuary. Upon rising, he is immediately consecrated as a priest. The imagery is stark: the old self dies, and a priest rises in his place! The reason that we celebrate a priest's anniversary of ordination is that God is at work in sanctifying His people.



Is your food expense over 50% in the last years? We have notice a major increase. While working on the next budget, looking over the last year, we have:

- \Rightarrow Replaced hot water heater in Rectory that went out.
- \Rightarrow Replaced 6 old computers having issue.
- \Rightarrow Upgraded our phone system.
- ⇒ Replaced the fire panels in the Youth Center & Holy Family House to keep us safe.

Some things happen, and you have no control. Like next fiscal year, Medical Insurance increasing 9%, Property & Casualty Insurance increasing 18% and Worker's Comp increasing 5%.

We are thankful to announce our offertory is around 9% above last year totals. This increase reflects the Offertory Drive Fr. Thuerauf started to help with the Air Handler Unit (AHU) project. We are grateful we have been able to make payments with this increase and all the extra AHU donations received.
