

## **Pastor's Blog**

## The Priesthood

The month of June is customarily the month for priestly ordinations. I was



ordained on June 5th twenty-five years ago. Around the country we have seen some "bumper crops" of priests being ordained. In the Archdiocese of Washington, 16 men were ordained as priests on June 15th. In the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, Archbishop Gomez ordained 11 men as priests on June 1st. Here in the Archdiocese of Denver we welcomed 6 men to the priesthood this year.

These ordinations make me ponder the priesthood once again. The nature of being a priest is to be conformed unto Jesus Christ the Head. In Latin, this expression is rendered as "in persona Christi capitis" and it means that the priest is the same Jesus. Just as Jesus gave His body and blood on the cross as a sacrifice for us, so the priest gives us that same body and blood in the Mass. Just as Jesus forgave repentant sinners, so the priest forgives sins in the confessional. Just as Jesus healed persons who approached him humbly, so the priest administers the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick to those who are seriously ill. All this ministry of Jesus is done with the same love which God showed us when He was incarnate and born of the Blessed Virgin Mary! I love being a priest! As Saint John Vianney once observed, "Oh, the greatness of the priest! If we could know his greatness we would surely die... not of fear but of love!"



**Baptisms:** A pre-baptismal session is required for parents and godparents. Please call the office at 303-988-6435 before or after the child's birth, before you choose godparents, to register. **The next class is July 27th from 9am-12pm** in the Community Center lower level.
