JOHN 6 | PREACHING SERIES

Pray the Rosary!





If anyone asks you

why you believe that the Eucharist is really the body and blood of Jesus you can simply respond, "Because I believe in the bible." In chapter six of John's gospel Jesus says, "For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him." (55-56 RSV)

I have the gift of leading the preaching series on John 6 today. For the next six weeks, each Sunday homily will focus upon this important chapter of John's gospel. This series has been promulgated by Archbishop Aquila and you will hear similar homilies at every parish in the Archdiocese of Denver until the series ends on August 25th. We need to continue to convert our souls, our parishes and our world to Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist. As Pope Francis said to the National Eucharistic Congress Committee on June 19, 2023, "Sadly, nowadays, there are those among the Catholic faithful who believe that the Eucharist is more a symbol than the reality of the Lord's presence and love." Flannery O'Connor once famously said of the Eucharist, "Well, if it's just a symbol, to hell with it!" What we receive at Sunday Mass is more than a symbol. We are assured by the words of our Lord Jesus Christ Himself that the Eucharist is really and truly His body and blood. May the Lord soften our souls to receive Jesus with love and devotion!

Religious Special Education is designed to help the developmentally disabled learn about Jesus. We work with the

students to celebrate their Sacraments and learn about Christian living in today's world. The class is designed to meet the needs of each student individually. We try to keep a 1:1 or 1:2 teacher/student ratio. Material for each student is based on what the student will be learning and their level of understanding. Our students that have already received all their sacraments, go over the Sunday Gospels (they read the gospel for the upcoming Sunday), while others choose to study the saints, the Rosary, Mary, and other topics of our faith.

Each Tuesday, we start with large group prayer where we each share prayer intentions, then we pray the Our Father, Hail Mary and the Glory Be. After prayer, we break up into individual classes or small groups to go over the lesson for the day. We celebrate Mass monthly with Fr. Roland Freeman during our class time. Classes meet on Tuesday nights from 6:30pm to 7:30pm starting August 27th, in the lower level of the Community Center. For more information, please contact Diane Schreiber at 303-980-5504.


