

Mission Statement



Who Do You Say I Am?

This Sunday Our Lord asks us two questions. The first is, "Who do people say that I am?" The disciples give a 1st century Jewish answer. "Some say John the Baptist, others Elijah, still others one of the prophets."

We answer his question with a 21st century American answer. Some say you are a myth, others a fairy tale. Some say you are a teacher – but they prefer other teachers. Others say you are a nice guy who agrees with everything they say and do so as not to offend. Some say you are a hater who is intolerant of what they believe. Still others say "don't know, don't care."

But then he asks the second (and more important) question: "But who do you say that I am?" And with a quiet and reverent voice, we answer, "You are the one who loves me unconditionally. You meet me where I'm at – in all my sinfulness and brokenness – you forgive me and take me by the hand and lead me to holiness. You are the source of my joy and my peace. You are my teacher – who teaches me how to love God and neighbor with all my heart. You are the bread come down from heaven who gives me your very self at every mass and transforms me from sinner to saint. You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God."

Now that's good news – go out and tell the world.

We will be having a training/information session on Saturday,


September 28, 2024 from 10am to
