The Bells of St. Jude

What's that sound?



When I first arrived as Pastor of St. Jude Parish, many of you asked, "Are you going to bring back the bells at Mass?" The answer is...yes! Beginning this weekend, at every mass where we have altar servers (hint – sign up your children to be servers!), we will hear the bells at Mass.

We were in a little shop during our pilgrimage to Mexico and these bells were calling out to me to bring them home for use in our church.

The ringing of bells during Mass dates back many centuries. The priest would celebrate Mass in Latin facing the same direction as (i.e. with his back to) the people. Bells would be rung at the most important parts of the Mass to alert the people that something sacred was happening. The bells are traditionally rung once when the celebrant extends his hands over the gifts at the epiclesis – the calling down of the Holy Spirit upon the bread and wine. Then, they are rung three times each during the elevations of the host and the chalice at the consecration – the moment when the bread and wine are changed into the body and blood of Christ. The bells announce to us that Jesus has, once again, come to be in our midst.

How beautiful is our Catholic faith. May the sound of the bells lift our hearts in praise to God!


