We Begin Again



There is a beautiful structure called the Roman Arch. It is comprised of an arch supported by two columns. The result is a gateway.

Our faith is like that arch. It is a gateway that leads from earth to heaven. The two columns which support the arch are the two great mysteries of our faith: The Incarnation and the Paschal Mystery.

The Incarnation: God loves us so much that He became one of us. The Paschal Mystery: That same God-man suffered, died and rose from the dead so that we might live forever with Him in heaven. These two central mysteries of our faith are so important that we spend over a third of the liturgical year contemplating and unpacking them.

This weekend we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent – the beginning of our liturgical year. In the coming weeks, we will contemplate the radical mystery that God entered history and lived among us.

Today we begin a retreat – a spiritual journey that will lead us to a humble stable in Bethlehem. The theme of this first week of our Advent retreat is found in this weekend's psalm: "He teaches the humble his way." Today, by repentance and conversion, we begin again to conform our hearts to the heart of Jesus who comes in humility. God waits for us on the other side of the gateway – but he also dwells among and within us. What a wonderful mystery. Let us begin.

Music Changes for the Liturgical Seasons

Just as each of Earth's seasons is characterized by distinct manifestations of God's beauty, each liturgical season of the church year provides different opportunities for spiritual enrichment and growth.
