Prepare the Way of the Lord

In the ancient world, when a king came to visit, a messenger would go before him to announce his coming. This gave everyone a chance to prepare for his arrival. In addition, the road that the king would travel was made ready – rough areas made smooth, potholes filled in, curves straightened.

This second week of Advent we find ourselves in the desert with John the Baptist. His mission was foretold by the Prophet Isaiah: A voice of one crying out in the desert: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight his paths. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be made low. The winding roads shall be made straight, and the rough ways made smooth.

John prepares the way for the King of Kings – both for the citizens of Judea and for us. He calls us to examine our lives and make our hearts ready.

Have you lost your way? John points us to Jesus – the way the truth and the life. Are you stuck in a valley of sin? John takes us to Jesus whose merciful hand lifts us up. Do you struggle with mountains of pride and self-sufficiency? John leads us to Jesus, meek and humble of heart. Is your road winding and rough? John introduces us to the One whose yoke is easy and burden light.

Let us go out to the desert and encounter the prophet who prepares us to meet Our Lord.


