### Glory to God in the Highest

Isn't it wonderful to receive a birth announcement in the mail? We rejoice with friends as they share the news of their child's birth.

Jesus Christ was the only person in history whose birth announcements were sent out before his actual birth. Over 300 prophecies, centuries before his birth, foretold the coming of the Messiah. As we transition from the Fourth Sunday of Advent to Christmas, we hear the words of the Prophet Micah spoken 700 years before the birth of Christ: From you, Bethlehem shall come forth one whose origin is of old. His greatness shall reach to the ends of the earth; he shall be peace.

This week we find ourselves in Bethlehem, kneeling in silent contemplation before the newborn Savior. How God would choose to come amongst us as a tiny infant is more than we can comprehend. Pope Benedict XVI helps us:

God makes himself small for us.

He does not come with power and outward splendor. He comes as a baby – defenseless and in need of our help.



1917. It encourages consecration to Mary Immaculate for spiritual renewal of individuals and society. The next meeting is January 13th.


