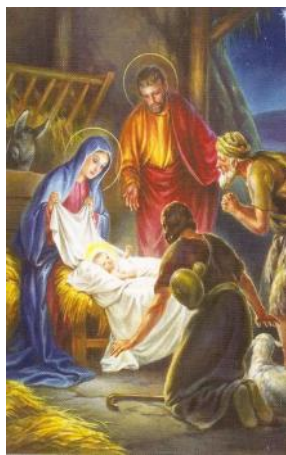

**Jubilee Year – Part Three  
What is a Pilgrimage?**



This is the third in a four-part series reflecting on the Jubilee year 2025.

The Jubilee is a year of abundant grace. One of the ways to experience this is by going on a pilgrimage. A pilgrimage is a spiritual journey to a holy place for the purpose of drawing closer to God. Christians have been making pilgrimages since the first centuries.

While major pilgrimages are often made to the Holy Land or Rome, during the Jubilee Year, we here in Colorado will have opportunities closer to home.

The pilgrimage sites in Colorado for the Jubilee Year 2025 are:

1. The Cathedral Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Denver
2. St. Stephen Church in Glenwood Springs
3. Holy Name Church in Steamboat Springs
4. Our Lady of Peace Church in Silverthorne
5. St. John the Evangelist in Loveland
6. St. Francis of Assisi in Longmont
7. St. Helena in Fort Morgan
8. St. Anthony in Sterling
9. The Mother Cabrini Shrine in Golden

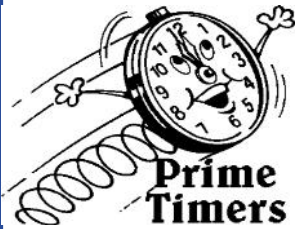

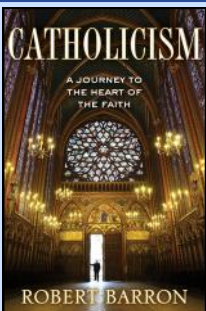


