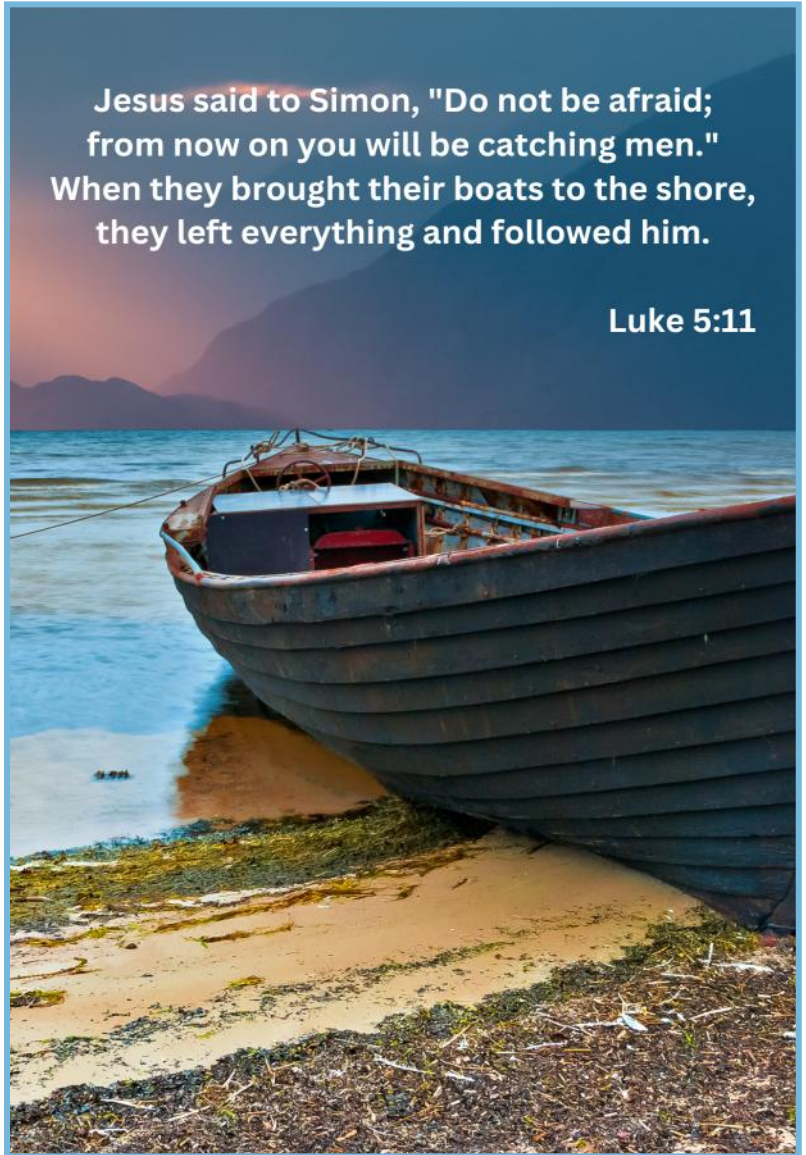

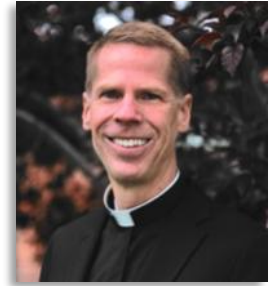

Jubilee Year – Part Four What is a Plenary Indulgence?

This is the last in a four-part series reflecting on the Jubilee year 2025.

One of the great graces of the jubilee year is a plenary indulgence – the remission of the temporal punishment due to sin. Sin is forgiven by making a good confession. But sin has a residual effect on us. It increases our attachment to sin and weakens our resistance to it. It also damages relationships. Even though a sin is forgiven, these residual effects need to be purified. That is what is meant by temporal punishment – think purification. This can be done here on earth or, by God's mercy, in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence during the Jubilee Year is gained by the following:

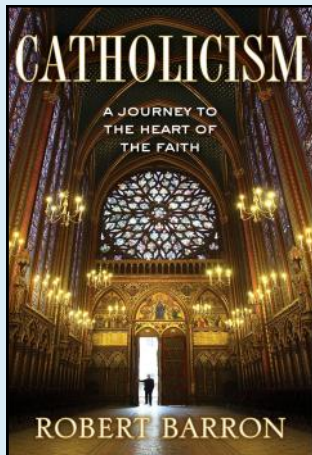
- Have the interior disposition of complete detachment from all sin
- Go to confession
- Receive Holy Communion
- Pray for the Holy Father's intentions (Our Father, Hail Mary)
- Perform an "indulged act". These include a visit to a pilgrimage site (see last week's column), performing corporal or spiritual works of mercy or doing acts of penance.

The sacred rites and prayers are to be carried out within 20 days of the indulged act. Indulgences can be applied to oneself or to souls in Purgatory, but they cannot be applied to other living persons.

What a great gift of grace is the Jubilee Year! Take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to become more closely conformed to Christ. Indulge yourself!


