



Radical Christianity

David had his chance. King Saul in his jealousy had plotted to kill young David. This wasn't the first time Saul and his soldiers had pursued David. Now David had crept into Saul's camp at night and found himself standing over his sleeping king. God had delivered David's enemy into his hand! It would have been easy with a single thrust of Saul's own spear to be done with the wicked king once and for all. But David spared his king's life that night and, as a result, Saul's heart softened.

A thousand years later, the One they called the Son of David, would speak the most radical idea ever taught: "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you." As he hung dying on the cross, Jesus would demonstrate that teaching to the extreme, "Father, forgive them." His followers would go to their own deaths on the cross or in the Coliseum with prayers and songs on their lips.

Now, two thousand years later, we, his disciples, still pray for the grace to be able to live out that radical teaching. We have so many enemies today – foreign and domestic, ideological, political, religious. Our Lord came to teach us that, as children of one God, we all have only one enemy – the Father of Lies whose sworn mission is to take hostage every human soul. Everyone else is a brother or sister.


St. Francis Sewing Circle


