
Penance Services for Lent



Holiness is not Optional

This week on our Lenten journey,



Robert Cardinal Sarah grew up in West Africa. He witnessed firsthand the persecution of the African Church by the communists. As Bishop, he was targeted for assassination. The title of his biography is "God or Nothing". He knows the cost of discipleship and has seen the death that comes from the rejection of God.

The word repent means "to feel such sorrow for sin as to be disposed to change one's life for the better." It comes from two Latin root words: rep – to crawl and paenitere – to regret. When we repent, the Holy Spirit has made us aware of our sins and we regret having committed them. Then we fall to our knees and beg for God's mercy. Fortunately, God's mercy is endless and His grace, transforming.

The journey of 1000 miles begins with a single step. The first step of the journey to heaven is repentance. In your Lenten journey, have you repented yet? Our parish night of confession will be April 2nd at 7pm in the church.
