Welcome Home

Last week, the Lord urged us to repent. This week we find out what happens when we do...

This Sunday, Jesus gives us the most famous story ever told – the parable of the Prodigal Son. We all know the story well. We have meditated upon this parable throughout our lives – often inserting ourselves into the story. We have been the restless younger son who turned his back on his father, leaving everything in search of happiness somewhere else. And we have been the father, heartbroken, longing for the return of his wayward child.

At the core of this parable, Jesus reveals to us the heart of our Heavenly Father. The wayward son eventually hits bottom. He recognizes his sin – he has rejected his father. He repents, and he starts to make his way back toward home.


Every day, the father has been walking to the end of the road, peering off into the distance, hoping to see any sign of his son's return. Finally, the day comes! He catches sight of his son a long way off. He runs to meet him, embracing and kissing him. His son was dead and came back to life again. He was lost and was found.






Standing with Mary at the Foot of the Cross

Baptisms: A pre-baptismal session is required for parents and godparents. Please call the office at 303-988-6435 before or after the child's birth, before you choose godparents, to register. **The next class is May 24th from 9am-12pm** in the Community Center lower level.

Marriage: Those who wish to be married at St. Jude Church must be registered in the parish for at least one




